VOTER REGISTRATION FOR THE 2014 NAVAJO NATION PRIMARY ELECTION IS CLOSED AS OF JULY 28, 2014 AT 5:00 PM TO FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2014.

THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION WILL NOT DO VOTER REGISTRATION VERIFICATIONS DURING THIS TIME.

ABSENTEE VOTING

THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION WILL NOT BE HOLDING EARLY ONSITE ABSENTEE VOTING AT THE URBAN LOCATIONS FOR THE 2014 NAVAJO NATION PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTION. THE OPTION OF VOTING BY AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION FOR VOTERS WHO WILL NOT BE ABLE TO VOTE ON ELECTION DAY AT THEIR RESPECTIVE CHAPTERS. THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION ENCOURAGES REGISTERED VOTERS IN URBAN LOCATIONS TO VOTE BY MAIL.

FOR A BALLOT TO BE MAILED OUT, YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION MUST PHYSICALLY BE IN ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION ON OR PRIOR TO MONDAY, AUGUST 11, 2014.

ABSENTEE VOTING IS OPEN AS OF JULY 28, 2014. WALK-IN ABSENTEE VOTING IS OPEN UNTIL FRIDAY, AUGUST 22, 2014 AT 5:00 PM.

VOTED ABSENTEE BALLOTS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE ANY OF THE NAVAJO ELECTION ADMINISTRATION OFFICE LOCATIONS BY 5:00 PM TUESDAY, AUGUST 26, 2014. VOTED ABSENTEE BALLOTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THE POLLING PLACES.
