

RESOLUTION OF THE
NAVAJO BOARD OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS

**Extending Time for Appointment for Forty-Five (45) days to fill vacant position for
Alamo Navajo School Board with Alamo Chapter**

WHEREAS:

1. The Navajo Board of Election Supervisors of the Navajo Nation is empowered by 11 N.N.C. §321(A)(1) to administer, implement and enforce the Navajo Nation Election Code; concerning filling vacancies by appointment, the Board pursuant to 11 N.N.C. §161(C) has the authority to extend time periods when necessary.
2. Alamo Chapter is looking to extend filing time for Alamo Navajo School Board, Inc. The previous school board member passed away and no recommendation was made.
3. It is in the best interest of Alamo Chapter that the time period for making an appointment to their respective position be extended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Navajo Board of Election Supervisors hereby extends the appointment deadline for forty-five (45) days for the vacant position with Alamo Chapter. The appointment and filing period shall re-open from 8:00 A.M. on November 15, 2019 to 5:00 P.M. on December 29, 2019. The Chapter shall no later than the closing date approve and submit its resolution recommending an appointment; copy of the resolution shall be submitted to the Election Administration.
2. The Navajo Election Administration shall notify the affected Chapter and shall further advise that, under Navajo Nation Law, no filing fees are required for appointments.
